Dear parents and carers,

We are writing to give you an update regarding the news you may have seen about COVID-19 testing in schools. At the moment, the information is coming through and being updated all the time, so we are writing this with the most up to date information that we have as of this morning.

The plan for the start of term in January, whilst subject to change, currently stands as follows:

Monday 4th January – Staff INSET day as previously planned (no students on site).

Tuesday 5th January – Remote learning will commence for most students, however children of keyworkers and those categorised as vulnerable will be invited into school from 8.45am-3.15pm.

Wednesday 6th -Friday 8th January - Remote learning will continue for most students. Children of keyworkers and those categorised as vulnerable will be invited into school. Student COVID-19 testing will also begin once consent has been obtained and we have more information of how the testing should take place.

Monday 11th January – All students will return to school and regular COVID-19 testing will continue (as directed by the Government).

If you are a keyworker, and you require your daughter to be in school from Tuesday 5th -Friday 8th January, please email us your daughter's name, form and your role by Saturday 2nd January 2021. Please send this information to info@woolwichpolygirls.co.uk

Once term begins, we will be sending documentation regarding testing and seeking consent from families for student testing along with any more information that we receive. Please check your emails regularly in order to be fully informed.
